1a) Look up high. Which building does this ship sail above? Elder Park Library, the Pearce Institute (P.I), or Fairfield Heritage?

2a) Where can you find this little creature? Is it on the Pearce Institute, Brechin's Bar, or Elder Park Library?

2b) What kind of creature do you think it is?

3a) How many people in 'Mrs Barbour's Army' on the statue at Govan cross are wearing hats?
